General Appearance

The Burmese Mountain Dog represents a strong, muscular and active dog, symmetrical and balanced in outline. A mature Burmese Mountain Dog is a handsome, upstanding and athletic dog, capable of great endurance with a fair (good) amount of speed. Of even, dignified temperament, the Burmese Mountain Dog is devoted and affectionate to his master, reserved with strangers. The peculiarity of this breed is the dark v-shaped area on its chest.

Size, Proportion, Substance

A mature Burmese Mountain Dog should be symmetrical in outline, slightly longer than tall but well balanced. Dogs-25 to 27 inches in height; Bitches-24 to 26 inches in height. Desirable weight: Dogs-65 pounds; Bitches-70 pounds.

Head

Should be of fair length, the skull flat and rather broad between the ears and should be free from wrinkles when in repose. The stop should be reasonably well defined. Eyes-should be moderately well apart and should be round, bright and sparkling with intelligent expression, their color harmonizing with the color of the dog. Ears-should be set rather high, of medium size, rather wide at the base and tapering to a rounded point. They should be carried close to the head. Muzzle-should be long, deep and powerful. The lips clean, closely fitting the jaws. Nose-should be black, brown or liver, in keeping with the color of the dog. No other colored nose is permissible. A black nose should be accompanied by dark eyes, a brown or liver nose with amber eyes. Bite-jaws level and strong with well-developed teeth, especially the canines or holders. Scissors bite preferred.

History

Though few people realize it, Oklahoma has enjoyed a rich regional tradition of winemaking since Indian Territory days. Our mild climate and moderate rainfall are ideally suited for the production of grapes, spurring the talents of winemakers for the last 150 years.

Sequoyah, famed creator of the Cherokee Alphabet, established the first successful winery in Indian Territory in 1843. Located 5 miles southwest of Tahlequah, the Sequoyah Winery produced a port and two varieties of claret.



The Oklahoma Land Rush of 1889 brought hundreds of eager winemakers into the new Oklahoma Territory. Perhaps the most successful was David Murray, father of future governor William H. Murray. His famous "Murray Mosel" frequently graced the White House table early in the century after President Theodore Roosevelt.

Even today, Oklahoma wines remain the wine of choice for many official functions at the White House. In a recent address to the 23rd Annual Convention of OKAWP, President Clinton declared Oklahoma wines to be a "unique treasure" and "a source of pride for all Americans".



Statistics

Wine production has always been important to the Oklahoma economy. From its humble beginnings in Sequoyah's back yard, wines became a leading product of Oklahoma early in the century, accounting for 4% of the Gross State Product by 1920. The Dust Bowl era of the 1930s witnessed the almost complete destruction of many wineries as the state's vineyards suffered terrible devastation. But the industry rebounded after World War II with improved agricultural practices, soil enrichment schemes, and federal subsidies.

Congress Threatens To Leave D.C. Unless New Capitol Is Built

WASHINGTON, DC—Calling the current U.S. Capitol “inadequate and obsolete,” Congress will relocate to Charlotte or Memphis if its demands for a new, state-of-the-art facility are not met, leaders announced Monday.

“Don’t get us wrong: We love the drafty old building,” Speaker of the House Dennis Hastert (R-IL) said. “But the hard reality is, it’s no longer suitable for a world-class legislative branch. The sight lines are bad, there aren’t enough concession stands or bathrooms, and the parking is miserable. It hurts to say, but the capitol’s time has come and gone.”

“If we want to stay competitive, we need to upgrade,” said House Minority Leader Dick Gephardt (D-MO), who has proposed a new \$3.5 billion capitol on the site of the current edifice. “Look

at British Parliament. Look at the Vatican. Respected institutions in their markets. But without modern facilities, they’ve been having big problems attracting top talent.”

Its cornerstone laid in 1793 by President Washington, the capitol has been built, rebuilt, extended, and restored countless times over the past 209 years. Legislators say another multimillion-dollar renovation is not an acceptable alternative to a new building.

“How many times can you put a fresh coat of paint over an old, broken-down horse?” asked Sen. Rick Santorum (R-PA), co-chair of the Senate Relocation Subcommittee.

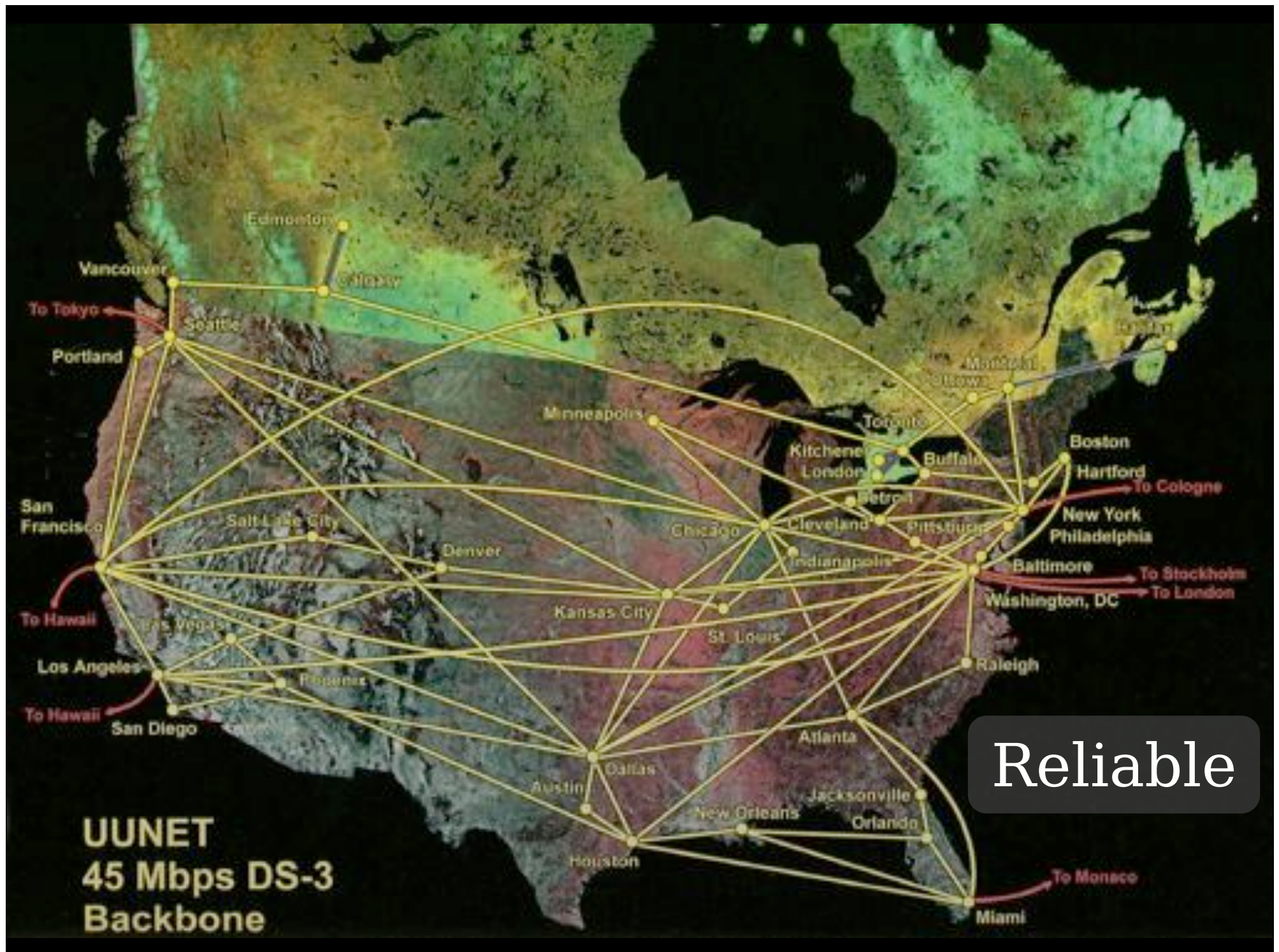



I am the author of the book [The Hoax of the Twentieth Century: The Case Against the Presumed Extermination of European Jewry](#) (1976), a work of "Holocaust revisionism".

This Web site exists for the purpose of expressing views that are outside the purview of my role as an Electrical Engineering faculty member. The material will be continually updated and revised, but will always have an emphasis on Holocaust revisionism.

It is intended to keep this Web site relatively simple, at least as far as this home page appears to the reader. For much more on Holocaust revisionism the reader can start with the Web site of the journal [The Revisionist](#).

The initial aim of this site, as inaugurated on 7 May 1996, is to present my article [A short introduction to the study of Holocaust revisionism](#), published in 1991 in the Daily Northwestern, with supplementing commentary and documentation. The links were last updated on 29 December 2005.

A second aim is to present [news items](#) of particular interest to Holocaust revisionists. This material was last updated on 22 December 2005.

A short introduction to the study of Holocaust revisionism,

by Arthur R. Butz.

I see three principal reasons for the widespread but erroneous belief in the legend of millions of Jews killed by the Germans during World War II: US and British troops found horrible piles of corpses in the west German camps they captured in 1945 (e.g. Dachau and Belsen), there are no longer large communities of Jews in Poland, and historians generally support the legend.

During both world wars Germany was forced to fight typhus, carried by lice in the constant traffic with the east. That is why all accounts of entry into the [German concentration camps](#) speak of shaving of hair and showering and other delousing procedures, such as treatment of quarters with the pesticide [Zyklon](#). That was also the main reason for a [high death rate in the camps](#), and the crematoria that existed in all.

When Germany collapsed in chaos then of course all such defenses ceased, and typhus and other diseases became rampant in the camps, which quartered mainly political prisoners, ordinary criminals, homosexuals, conscientious objectors, and Jews conscripted for labor. Hence the [horrible scenes](#), which however had nothing to do with "extermination" or any deliberate policy. Moreover the west German camps involved were not the alleged "extermination camps", which were all in Poland (e.g. Auschwitz and Treblinka) and which were all evacuated or shut down before capture by the Soviets, who found no such scenes.

The "Final Solution" spoken of in the German documents was a program of evacuation, resettlement and deportation of Jews with the ultimate objective of expulsion from Europe. During the war Jews of various nationalities were being moved east, as one stage in this Final Solution. The legend claims that the motion was mainly for extermination purposes.

What we are offered in evidence was gathered after the war, in trials. The evidence is almost all oral testimony and "confessions". Without the evidence of these trials there would be no significant evidence of "extermination". One must pause and ponder this carefully. Were trials needed to determine that the Battle of Waterloo happened? The bombings of Hamburg, Dresden, Hiroshima and Nagasaki? The slaughter in Cambodia? Yet this three year program, of continental scope, claiming millions of victims, requires trials to argue its reality. I am not arguing that the trials were illegal or unfair; I am arguing that such historical logic as the legend rests on must not be countenanced. Such events cannot happen without generating commensurate and contemporaneous evidence for their reality, just as a great forest fire cannot take place without producing smoke. One may as well believe that New York City was burned down, if confessions to the deed can be produced.

Detailed consideration of the specific evidence put forward in support of the legend has been a focus of the revisionist literature and cannot be undertaken here, but I shall mention one point. The claim of the legend is that there were no technical means provided for the specific task of extermination, and that means originally provided for other purposes did double duty in improvised arrangements. Thus the Jews were allegedly gassed with the pesticide [Zyklon](#), and their corpses disappeared into the [crematoria](#) along with the deaths from "ordinary" causes (the ashes or other remains of millions of victims never having been found).

Surely any thoughtful person must be skeptical.
