

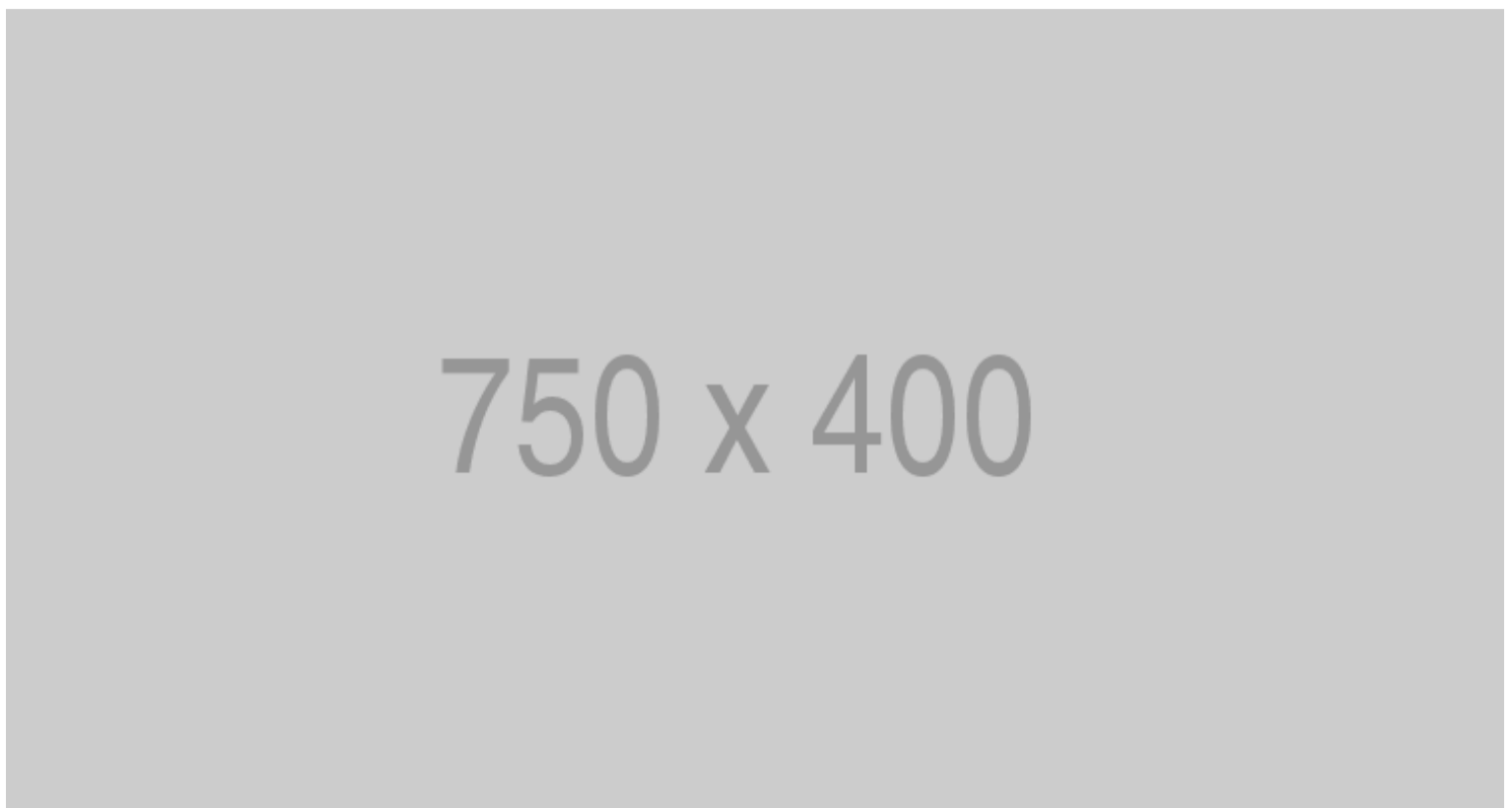

Colors for Painting

Modern scientific color theory, which argues that magenta, yellow, and cyan are the best set of three colorants to combine, for the widest range of high-chroma colors but the Red, Yellow, Blue color model still rules the world of artistic painting.

Color Theory

In the visual arts, *color theory* is a body of practical guidance to color mixing and the visual effects of a specific color combination. There are also definitions (or categories) of colors based on the color wheel: primary color, secondary color and tertiary color.
